Partners will insure compliance to any applicable environmental regulation, both on and off the Aluminerie Alouette site. Business Partners will measure, manage and report environmental incidents and data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Partners will continuously improve environmental and resource management – reduce, reuse and recycle.

Partners will take all practical and reasonable measures to implement environmentally friendly technologies and processes in their activities.

BUSINESS PRACTICES

Compliance with laws and regulations

Partners must abide by all applicable laws and regulations. The laws that govern our activities can be complex, but ignoring them does not relieve Business Partners or its employees from their obligation to abide by them.

Corruption, bribery and improper business conduct

Partners will not commit, or become involved in, bribery or corruption of any form, including facilitation payments that would provide an advantage in the conduct of business, offer, promise or give anything of value or an undue advantage to a public official or to any third party to influence such person to act or refrain from acting in relation to the performance of their duties.

Partners will ensure personal activities and interests, and those of their employees and subcontractors do not take part in or seek to influence any decision where there are related circumstances, factors or relationships (business, personal, economic or otherwise) that could give rise to an actual or perceived conflict.

Partners will not request, offer, promise, give or accept gifts, favors or hospitality which are more than modest, both with respect to value and frequency, or are inappropriate with respect to time and place in relation with tender or contract negotiation/award processes.

Partners will not enter into, seek to enter into or otherwise engage in any form of agreement, arrangement or activity that would be a breach of applicable competition laws and regulations.

HUMAN RIGHTS AND WORKING CONDITIONS

In accordance with the United Nations' Universal Declaration of Human Rights, laws and regulations we promote a fair and free of harassment work environment.
